Leviticus begins by describing the five kinds of offerings or sacrifices for Israel (chapters 1-7). This lesson covers sin and trespass or guilt offerings, which were mandatory.

- 2. When would the sinner know to bring a sin offering (see 4:22, 27)?
- 3. What were the different categories of people who would bring sin offerings (4:3, 22, 27)?
- 4. What were some of the differences in the sin offerings for different classes of people?
- 5. In chapter 5 what are some of the sins that required sin offerings?
- 6. What options did the poor have?

- 7. What was the main difference in what one had to do for a sin and a trespass/guilt offering?
- 8. In chapter 6 what were some of the sins that required trespass/guilt offerings?

- 10. How would you describe those kinds of sins, and what was the punishment for them?
